## Did you know.....

- 23 states now have state-run online schools
- 13 states, including Minnesota, have specific policies regarding course providers, access, and funding for online programming
- In Minnesota there were 33 approved online learning public school providers that represent a mix of consortia, regional service districts, charter school programs, and district programs serving students statewide.
- Overall growth in online learning is around 6% nationwide; increasing for the fourteenth straight year.
- Nationwide, 30% of higher education students are taking online coursework.
- In Minnesota, 42.9% of higher education students were taking at least one online course; higher than the national average.

I wanted to share these statistics to highlight the growing trend students will encounter as they pursue post-secondary opportunities.

Over 14 years ago, visionary leaders in our districts wanted to develop a way for students to start "learning how to learn online" while still having the traditional high school support system that many students still need. And thus, Infinity Online was born!

Infinity Online monitors student progress on a weekly basis, identifying students that may need assistance, guidance or intervention. We work directly with the local school counselor, wherever possible, to review with students their current progress, issues with pace and completion, barriers to success, and develop a path to success.

I believe it is this collaborative approach that helps elevate student success rates to 90% while preparing students for learning beyond their high school years.

**How do you schedule students into online courses?** Students meet with the school counselor to help with the registration of online classes and complete the needed forms. Students in 9th and 10th grade are scheduled into a Study Hall during their online class time. 11th and 12th graders can work wherever they choose, unless they are struggling in the online class. If that is the case, they are also assigned a Study Hall.
